## APPNA Committee On Young Physician's (CYP) Spring Meeting Report March 25<sup>th</sup>, 2017

This year's CYP has sixteen members including chair (Dr. Iqbal) and co-chairs (Drs. Aized, Faheem, Khan, and Nadeem). CYP has laid out 9 projects for this year. One or more CYP members are leading each project. Dr. Faheem leads 'Residency Match Assistance' project. A list of unmatched residency programs from 2011-2016 has been compiled and posted on our website. A team of CYP members will remain active during the match week from March 13-17, 2017. Our long-term goal will be to update the lists of current Pakistani-Descent residents and program directors.

A contact person has been established within the State Department. Out of two J-1 visa delays, one has been resolved.

Dr. A. Khan leads the online web-based system for observorships, externships, and research. Our goal this year is to increase the utilization of this program. Drs. Malhi and Iqbal monitor APPNA NY house. Two different CYP seminars are being planned during APPNA Summer convention July 5-9<sup>th</sup>, 2017 in Orlando, Florida. Dr. Latif will lead the research seminar. It'll include oral and poster presentations. Honoraria will be provided to the presenters. Drs. Waheed and Nadeem lead coaching seminar. It'll be 2.5 hours session and include lectures followed by question-answer session. CYP has requested APPNA EC for financial and logistic help.
