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

The Galata Tower & The Tunnel

It is one of the highest and oldest towers of Istanbul. 63 meter (206 feet) high tower provides a panoramic view of the old town. It was built in the 14th century by the Genoese colony as part of the defense wall surrounding their district at Galata directly opposite ancient Constantinopolis. After the conquest of

Constantinople by Mehmet II, it served to detect fires in the city.





Camlica Hill & Camlica Mosque

Camlica Hill located on Asian side just at the Uskudar district.; Camlica, a place with two hills overlooking the Bosphorus and the Marmara Sea, is one of the most favored promenades in Istanbul, and also one of the highest and most charming places in the city. Camlica Mosque has been the biggest Mosque built since Ottoman Empire.






Beylerbeyi Palace & Beylerbeyi Area

It is one of the cutiest palace fors o many people; built between 1861-1865 by head architects Sarkis Balyan and Agop Balyan, imperial architects of Armenian origins, in French neo-baroque style with a traditional Ottoman house plan. 


We will get Lunch at the Borsa Kandilli Restaurant where located at the old palace . Now this place using as school

Opportunity to see local products of the region like ches nut, honey, olive oil, Turkish delight and outlet center. Climb to mountain for barbecue lunch, free time for Atv safari or ski motor and skiing. Visit Ulucami (Grand Mosque), the old silk market in the Covered bazaar. Late evening retun to Istanbul and transfer to hotel.

Note: The cable car (teleferik) can not be operated due the weather conditions, If you want skiing, you should take minibus from restaurant to ski lopes, transportation and ski equipments are not included.




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Bursa is the fourth most populous city in Turkey and one of the most industrialized metropolitan centers in the country.

DAY 4 – Sep 10: Flight to Ankara, Ankara tour & Cappadocia Transfer & Overnight in Cappadocia




Early pick up at 06:30 am for Ankara 09:45 am flight Pegasus. Landing at Ankara Esenboga Airport

Visit to the **Anatolian** Civilizations Museum at which numerous remnants from Stone Age, Neolithic Age, Hittites, Urartians, Phrygians and many others are on display; Citadel of Ankara and the Mausoleum of Ataturk, the burial place of the national hero who founded modern Republic of Turkey.





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We will have lunch at the Tavacı Recep Usta




At the end of the tour transfer to Cappadocia takes around 3 to 4 Hours drive.


DAY 5 - Sep 11 : Cappadocia Tour & Overnight in Cappadocia

Breakfast at the hotel. Pick up at 10:30 for the Cappadocia tour.




Depart from your hotel to visit **Red** valley and explore the famous rock- cut churches and hike 5 km through the Gulludere valley.











Then visit **Cavusin** village. Old Cavusin was abandoned several decades ago due to avalanches. The current village of Cavusin is located on the road. Old Cavusin, with its rock-cut dwellings and stone houses, had several hermitages.

The two most important churches in Cavusin are the Great Basilica dedicated to St. John the Baptist (located on the cliff above the village) and Cavusin Church or the


"Great Pigeon House" commemorating a visit of the famous Cappadocian Emperor Nicephorus Phocas.



After lunch in Han Restaurant, we drive to the **Pigeon Valley**








In the afternoon visit Kaymakli Underground City, where early Christians lived in fear and faith. The ancient name was Enegup. The houses in the village are constructed around the nearly one hundred tunnels of the underground city, which is one of the most interesting underground settlements in Cappadocia. The underground city

was originally carved out as eight floors; however four floors are available to visit. In wartime about 5000 people can refuge in. The tunnels are still used today as storage areas, stables, and cellars.

On the way back visit the **natural castles at Ortahisar**.




DAY 6 - Sep 12: Hot Air balloon, Cappadocia Tour & Overnight in Cappadocia

Hot air balloon tour at the sunrise Breakfast at the hotel




Our first real encounter with Cappadocia almost Martian landscape is in the **Dervent valley**.





We visit **Pasabag's "fairy chimneys"**, where the voice of the wind harmonizes with songs of the fairies. From here we pause at





Avanos centre of terracotta art which is a popular destination because of its attractive old town with cobbled streets, and views over the river and is its production of **earthenware pottery**; it is also the most economic activity in the town. The ceramic trade in this district and its countless pottery factories date right back to the Hittites, and the ceramic clay from the red silt of the Kızılırmak has always been used. A visit to ceramic & tile center to see how the ceramics made by hand.

After lunch in Sur Balik Restaurant we visit the famous **Goreme Open Air Museum** to see the best examples of Byzantine art in Cappadocia.

People of Goreme, at the heart of the Cappadocia Region, realized that these soft rocks could be easily carved out to form houses, churches, monasteries.

These Christian sanctuaries contain many examples of Byzantine art from the post-iconoclastic period. These frescoes are a unique artistic achievement from this period.

Visit the **Tomb of Rumi in the Museum of Mevlana**, an important place of pilgrimage for Muslims.




Then, we visit the Ottoman-era **Sultan Selim Mosque** before having lunch in Kuzuku Ali.

After our lunch we drive to the Alâeddin Hill (a prehistoric tumulus) to visit the 1000-year-old Alâeddin Mosque

In its courtyard are the tombs of many of the Seljuk Turkish sultans. Walking down the north side of the Aladdin Hill we pass the remains of the Seljuk sultan's palace, then cross the street for a view of the elaborate portal of the Ince Minareli Medrese theological college.
