



Summer Meeting CME Chair Report



Dear APPNA Members.

This year APPNA Summer convention was held at Gaylord resort in Washington DC during the 4th of July weekend. This year CME program was unique in a sense that for the first-time parallel specialty sessions were introduced and an introductory Podiatry CME session made its debut at the APPNA.

The CME program started early on Thursday July 4th with multispecialty session chaired by Dr Namirah Jamshed with talks on refractory hypertension by Dr. Azra Mahmud, landscape of primary care by Dr. Habib Chotani, Lifestyle medicine by Dr. Ilyas Yamani,

peripheral neuropathy by Dr. Waqar Waheed, primary care of older adults by Dr. Namirah Jamshed, neurogenerative diseases by Dr. Ejaz Shamim and in the end a motivating keynote lecture on ECMO during covid by Dr. Ali Tabatabai.

On the second day there were two parallel specialty sessions on Psychiatry and on Oncology. Both sessions had very well-known speakers who provided excellent insight into new developments in their respective fields. Psychiatry session was chaired by Dr, Mujeeb Shad and included talks on teenage addiction by Dr. Muhammad Zeeshan, teenage suicide by Dr Abdul Hameed and Dr Mujeeb Shad and mental wellness by Dr Farah Abbasi.

The oncology session was chaired by Dr. Hassan Kaleem and included talks by Dr. Pashtoon Kasi on Liquid Biopsies, Dr. Saad Usmani on Multiple Myeloma, Dr. Muzaffar Qizalbash on cell therapy for cancer, Dr. Jasmine Zain on CarT cells and Dr. Zainab Shahid on immunotherapy. All the talks were of very high caliber and delivered by leaders in the field.

The third day had three parallel sessions on Cardiology, Gastroenterology and Podiatry. Cardiology session was dedicated to Dr Shahbudin Rahimatoola and was highlighted by talks on Atrial fibrillation by Dr. Maria Viqar, Peripheral Vascular Disease by Dr. Salman Arain, Structural heart disease by Dr. Mohamad Ansari, Carotid artery stenting by Dr. Tariq Shahab, Risk assessment of CV disease by Dr. Khurrum Nasir and treatment of myocardial infarction by Dr, Rameez Syed. Dr, Khurrum Moin organized this session.

Gastroenterology session had several interesting topics like interventional gastroenterology by Dr. Ali Siddiqui, Clinical application of MASH by Dr. Bilal Hameed, Inflammatory bowel disease by Dr. Tauseef Ahmed, Obesity and its management by Dr. Mariam Khalid, pancreatitis management by Dr. Musrtafa Arain and colon cancer screening by Dr. Asma Shaukat, this session was chaired by Dr Anis Memon and Dr Bilal Hameed.

The inaugural Podiatry session included provoking talks from Drs, Noman Siddiqui, Sara Mahmood, Hummira Abawi, Anam Khan, Bilal Khan and residents Hiba Mohiuddin and Shehreyar Raja.

The Grand Finale of the CME session was held on the topic of Artificial Intelligence and was moderated by Dr. Adnan Hyder who conducted a debate on whether AI provides hope or it's just a hype. The panelists included Omar Khawaja, Dr. Mona Siddiqui, Dr. Mohammad Khan and Dr. Qing Zheng. This session attracted the highest attendance and had a very stimulating discussion.

Overall, more than 350 registered for the CME session and despite parallel sessions, intriguing topics and stimulating discussions attracted a large audience. The experiment of having parallel sessions was very successful and future APPNA leadership is urged to continue this tradition and have more specialties included in future. One suggestion from many was to have the sessions open for interested physicians for free who are not interested in CME credits but still want to benefit from this educational program. Another suggestion was to post all the talks online as due to parallel sessions it was not possible to attend all sessions and enjoy all presentations.

In the end I would like to thank President Asif Mohiuddin, Chair of APPNA Summer meeting Dr Tariq Mahmood and Co-Chair Dr Tayyib Rana for their support for this program and hope to see even better educational activities in future APPNA meetings.
